Ordain this Writing as an for my Last will & Testament

Revoking all other wills by me here tofore ever made That is to say

Item I Give & Devise unto my Son Thomas Blunt all
my Lands lying & being in the aforesaid County of Southampton
as also my following Negroes To wit Cupit Jack, Jany
Moses & Judy to him & his heirs & assigns for Ever.

Item I Give Devise & bequeath unto my Daughter Mary
Blunt the following Negroes To wit, Simon, Pat
Mingo & Jany as also 1 horse Saddle & Bridle to the
Value of Twelve Pounds Ten Shillings, One feather &
furniture to the Value of Eight Pounds & Pewter to the
Value of two Pounds Current Money & one young Grey
Mare Colt Called and known by the name of Jany I Give
to her, her heirs & Assigns for ever.

Item I Give Devise & bequeath unto my beloved wife Sarah Blunt
the use & Labour of my Slaves Tom & Beck during the natural
life of her the said Sarah as also I Give her one feather bed
& Furniture to the Value of Eight Pounds Current money
but at her Deced my will is that the above Slave Tom
Decend to my son Thomas his heirs &c. & that other Slave
Beck Decend to my Daughter Mary to her her heirs & assigns
for Ever.

Item Now my will is that all the rest & residue of my Estate of
what nature or kind so Ever after all Just Debts & Legacies paid
may decend to my s^d son Thomas his heirs & assigns and I do
appoint my s^d wife Sarah & my son Thomas Exec^{rs} & Ex^{es}
of this my Last will & Testament In Witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand & affixed my Seal this 16 day of
January 1758.
