

In the name of God Amen I William Joyner of the County of Southampton being very sick & weak in Body but of perfect sense & memory thank's be to Almighty God for it do make & declare this my last Will & Testament revoking all former wills before by made first & principally I give my soul to Almighty & my Body to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian like manner by my Executors hereafter mentioned & as for my worldly Estate I give as followeth.

Item I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Underwood one Negro Woman named Hannah which I bought of Joseph Godwin & all her Increase to her & her heirs forever.

Item I give to my son William Joyner one negro Woman named Sarah & one negro girl named Sally one acre but saw & one hundred & seventy five acres of Land which I bought of Robert Little to him & his heirs forever.

Item I give to my son Israel Joyner one Hundred acres of Land which I took up & one negro girl named Hanna to him & his heirs forever.
