

Item I give to my Daughter Ann Vick one negro Girl named Patty with her Increase to her & her heirs forever

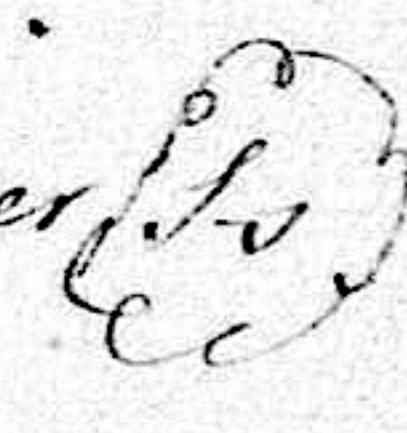
Item I give to my son Lewis Joyner one Negro Boy named James & one Negro Girl named Sary with her Increase to him & his heirs forever
