 one negro Woman call Hagar & Negro Boy call'd Solomon & fifty Acre
 of Land more or less bounded by a Line of mark trees from the Cabin
 Swamp to Godwin & I give to my Granddaughter Bilha Bennett one
 Negro Girl call Cathern to she & her heirs lawfully Begotten of her
 Body & I give to my Son John Bowin all Best of my Lands & Plantations
 the mill & what belongs to her one feather Bed that I lay in & what
 belongs to it & one Negro man call Simon - & I give to my Daughter
 Beck Griffon one Negro Woman call Jane & one negro call Bafe
