I do make make Ordain Constitute & Appoint my Two Sons William & Chaplin Williams Sents & Chaplin Williams Junr my whole & Sole Exors of this my Last Will & Testament & I do hereby Revoke all former Wills, Testaments, & Deeds of Gifts made by me or Signed by me to any person or persons whatsoever In Witness whereof I have set my hand & seal This Sixth day of October One Thousand seven Hundred & Fifty eight
