to God for it & calling to mind the mortality of my Body
& knowing it is appointed for all Person to die
make & ordain this my Last Will & Testament Principally
& first I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty
God that gave it me & my Body to the Ground to be buried
in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my
Executor & as touching such worldly Estate which it
has pleased God to bless me with in this life I give in
the following manner and form -

Item I give to my loving Sister Alice Bryant my Plantation &
all my Land also one feather Bed & furniture & one D.
& two sheets also four Counterpanes one large Looking glass
Three Cows & Calves one boar & hater & one spinning wheel
and all the remainder of my Estate be it in any kind or
Quality whatsoever that can be found to her heirs
forever.

I do hereby Appoint my trusty friend Wm Bryant my
hol & sole Executor to this my last Will & Testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed
my seal the 16th day of January anno Domⁿ 1761.
