I Moody Kirby of Southampton County in Virginia being in Perfect Health & memory & calling to mind the uncertainty of this Life do think Proper to make Constitution & Ordain This is my Last Will & Testament in Manner & form following —

Item I give & bequeath to my dear & loving wife Frances All my Estate of what nature or kind soever consisting of Negroes Stock in Household furniture &c unto my said wife whom I make Nominate & Appoint whole & sole Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament Witness my hand and seal this ninth Day of February 1757.
