Item I give unto my Son William Williford the Land & Plantation whereon
I now live with one hundred & fifty acres lying on the North side of
the above mentioned Broton branch be the same more or less to him
of his heirs forever Likewise I give unto my son William one Chest
of Drawers and one Trunk

Item I give unto my Grandson Benj. Williford five shillings Cash

Item I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth Jones five shillings Cash

Item I give unto my Daughter Mary Boasman five shillings Cash

Item I give unto my Daughter Lucy Williford five shillings Cash

Item I give unto my Daughter Mourning Williford five shillings Cash
and as to the rest of my Estate after my just Debts Legacies &
funerals expences are paid I give it all unto my wife & to be at
her disposing as she shall see fit and further I do nominate
of appoint my sons Thos. Williford & Wm Williford whole & sole
executors of this my Last Will & Testament Revoking
all former Wills by me made In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this fifteenth
Day of November one thousand seven hundred & Sixty
