James Jordan Scott, John Bryant & Woldman Joynes do make
the division amongst them — And lastly I Nominate
constitute & appoint my loving wife Anne & my son
William to be Executrix of this my Last Will & Testament as
Witnesses my hand & seal this 17th day of January 1761 —
