In the Name of God Amen I Simon Turner of
Southampton County being sick of weaks of Body
but of sound & perfect sense & Memory do make and
Appoint this to be my Last Will & Testament —
I recommend my Soul to Almighty God that gave
me & certain hope of a joyful Resurrection of the
same of my Body to the Earth to be Buried at the Discretion of
my executors hereafter mentioned & as to what
worldly Goods of hath pleased God to bestow on me
I dispose of them in the following Manner —
I give my Tract of Land, ^{lying} in Brunswick County on the
Trop Branch containing about three hundred & fifty
Acres to my son Simon & Willd to be divided by the
water Course of the said Trop Branch & all that Part on
the west side of the said Branch containing by estimation
one hundred & seventy five Acres of Land I give
to my son Simon to him & his Heirs forever and all
that Part of or the East side of the said Branch I give
to my son William to him & his Heirs forever —
Item I give my Tract of Land of one hundred & fifteen Acres
of Land lying joining on Metherin River in
