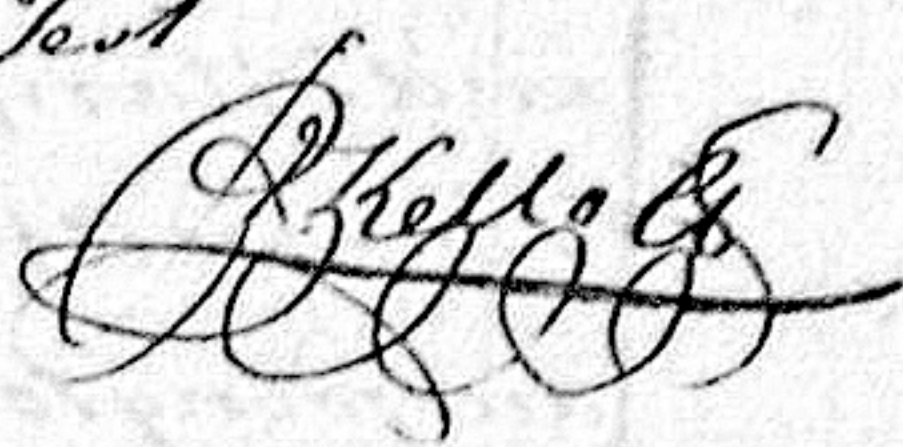

I Elizabeth Edwards of the Parish of Nottorway & County of
Southampton being sick and weak of Body but of sound
and disposing mind & memory thanks be given to almighty
God for the same do make and constitute this my last Will
and Testament in manner following To wit I give and

bequeath to my son Micah Edwards one Feather Bed and
Furniture also one Coward Calf also a pewter Basin & six
Spoons and 3 Head of Hogs also one Iron Pot & a Piggon
Item I give and bequeath to my son Joseph one Coward Calf
also one Pewter Basin & six Spoons also 3 Head of Hogs also
one Iron Pot and also a Tub

Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Patty one Feather Bed
and Furniture the little Shillet also a Pail also my
Negroe Girl Judah to keep and her Heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my son Wm Edwards my Horse
Bridle and Saddle

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Ann ten Shillings

Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Patience ten Shillings
my Will and Desire is if my son should die without
Heir that my son Berry should have the feather Bed
bequeathed to my son Micah & that the Cow & Calf
should be divided between my son Joseph and ^{Daughter} Martha
Lastly I do appoint my loving Sons Thomas and William
Edwards whole and Sole Executors of this my last Will &
Testament ratifying and confirming this and no other
to be my last will and Testament As Witness my
