one Pottle Jugg six Quart Bottles one Stone Mugg one Gun
and also my Land and Plantation whereon I now live after
he shall come to the Age of twenty years or not before to him &
his Heirs forever.

Item I give loving Son David Edmunds my Land and Plantation
which I bought of Benjamin Croker and also the Use of my
Plantation whereon I now live till my Grand Son Jonas
Edmunds comes to Age of Twenty one years and also the use and
remainder of my Estate both out Doors in Doors to him &
his Heirs forever.

Item I do make & ordain my loving Son David Edmunds Sole Executor
of this my Last Will and Testament In Witnes whereof I the
said Jeremiahs Edmunds have set my Hand and Seal the
Day and year above written.
