Item I give to my Daughter Mary Cotts one Shilling.

Item I give to my Son Thomas Lurbley one Shilling.

Item I give to my Son Jesse Lurbley one Shilling.

Item I leave the Use of ^{the Land on} my Plantation whereon I now live to my Loving Wife Elizabeth during her life or Widow Hood — then after her life or Widow hood I give the sd Land to my Son Richard Lurbley to be his Heirs forever.

Item I leave all the best of my Estate to my Loving Wife to pay my Debts and Cause the best of the Children that is not married in this Will and if any thing befall at my Wifes Death or widow wood I desire that it may be Equally Divided betwixt my small Children that is not mentioned in this Will In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal the Day & year above written
