Furthermore my Will and desire is that if my sd Son Benjamin should have Heir lawfully Begotten as aforesaid that then & in such Case all the Remainder of my Lands to be Equally Divided between my two Sons William & Nicholas & their Heirs forever but if my sd Son Benj^m should die without Heir lawfully Begotten of his Body then my desire is that my son Nicholas have no Right Title nor Interest in the Division of the sd Dividend of Land last mentioned but be the sole property of my son William and his Heirs forever.

I give and bequeath to my son William & his Heirs forever One feather Bed and Furniture which is now at my son Benj^m Gurley. Likewise give and bequeath to my son Nicholas & his Heirs forever One feather Bed & Furniture.

Last & my Will and desire is that the Remainder of my Estate that shall be left after Payment of my Debts and Legacies be & remain in my Wife Anns Hands during her life or Widowhood for the support of her self and Children but if she should Marry to be equally divided between my two Sons William and Nicholas & my said Wife Ann also I do appoint my trusty Friends Gen Gurley jr and Joseph Cobb whole and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament ratifying & confirming this and none other
