

457 Item I give devise & bequeath unto my Son Joel Davis All the rest of that Tract of Land which I bought of W^m Bailey below the Spring Branch binding upon Benyⁿ Sebrella and James Jones's Lines to him & his Heirs & Assigns forever.

Item I give the Use of my Plantation whereon I now live containing one hundred & ten Acres of Land to my beloved Wife Sarah Davis during her Natural Life and at decease I give Devise and bequeath the afo^d one hundred and ten Acres of Land to my Son Charles Davis to him & to his Heirs & Assigns forever.

Item I give devise & bequeath unto my Son Edwin Davis my Negro Girl Dianah to him and to his Heirs & Assigns forever.

* Item I give the Use & Labour of my other two Negroes Tom & Nan to my beloved Wife Sarah During her natural Life And all the best & residue of my Estate it being of What nature or kind soever after all Just Debts and Legacies paid I leave it after her Death to be Equally Divided between my Wife and all my Surviving Children and I do nominate and appoint my beloved Wife Sarah Davis Executrix and Thomas Davis Executor of this my Last Will and Testament and I do hereby renounce and make void all other Wills before by me ever made in Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and affix my Seal this 1st Day of February 1762.
