

part to the other of them two that is living and in case both of my afo<sup>d</sup> Daughters should Die without any lawfull Heir in that Case I give all their parts of the afo<sup>d</sup> Negroes which I have given them to my Son William Mackey after his Mothers decease the same to him and his Heirs forever.

Item my Will and desire is that my Negro Woman named Hannah Hall Her Increase be and remain in my Possession of my loving Wife Hope Mackey & for her Use during her natural life.

Item I give to my Son John Mackey fifteen Shillings current money after his Mothers decease and no more.

Item I give to my Daughter Hope joyner fifteen shillings current money after her Mothers decease & no more.

Item I give to my Daughter Dianer Bradshaw fifteen shillings current money after her mothers decease & no more.

Item I give to my grand Daughter Frances Armstead five shillings current money after my Wifes decease and no more.

Item I lend my loving Wife Hope Mackey all the rest & remainder of my Estate be it of what Kind or Quality soever During her natural life and after her decease to be Equally devideed among my three Children to say my Son William and my daughter Ann Mackey and my Daughter Sally Mackey the same to them and their Heirs forever.

Lastly I make Constitute Ordain and appoint my well beloved Friends Charles Powers & Robert Carr my whole & sole Execrs of this my last Will & Testament Revoking & Disannulling all other wills or Wills by me heretofore made or Declared In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and first my Seal this 29<sup>th</sup> Day of Decr 1761
