Item my Will and desire is that my Negro Woman named Hannah Vall her Increase be and remain in y^e Possession of my Loving Wife Hore Mackey for her Use during her natural Life.

Item I give to my Son John Mackey fifteen Shillings current Money after his Mothers decease and no more.

Item I give to my Daughter Hore Joyner fifteen shillings current money after her Mothers decease and no more.

Item I give to my Daughter Diarier Bradshaw fifteen shillings current money after her Mothers decease and no more.

Item I give to my Grand Daughter Frances Armistead five shillings current money after my Wifes decease and no more.

Item I lend ^{to} my Loving Wife Hore Mackey all the rest & remainder of my Estate be it of what Kind or Quality soever During her natural Life and after her decease to be Equally divided among my three Children to say my Son William and my daughter Ann Mackey and my Daughter Sally Mackey the same to them and their Heirs forever.

Lastly I make constitute ordain and appoint my well beloved Friend Charles Powers & Robert Carr my whole sole Exors of this my last Will & Testament Revoking & Disannulling all other Will or Wills by me heretofore made or Declared In Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and fixt my Seal this 29th Day of Dec^r 1761
