part of Orchard and Liberty of the Ground in Turning of their single
Lives afterwards then all to go to my Son Arthur Bradshaw he &
his Heirs forever Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Wife all
my worldly Estate and I do hereby appoint my loving Wife Mary
Bradshaw and my son Arthur Bradshaw to be my whole & sole
Executors to see this my last Will and Testament performed
