Item. my desire is that my loving Wife should have the Use of all
 the remaining part of my Estate of what nature or kind-
 Quality soever during her natural or widowhood & after her
 Death or Marriage I desire it may be Equally divided
 amongst all my Children and I do nominate and appoint my
 Friend Capt Timothy Thorpe whole and Sole Executor of this
 my last Will and Testament In Witnes whereof I have hereunto
 set my Hand & affixed my Seal this twentieth ninth Day of April
 one thousand seven hundred and sixty two
