in manner and forme as followeth.

I give and bequeath unto my son Hardy Doyle the Land
where he now lives beginning on Sarahs Branch at Coxyes
Line so up the said Branch to the head line then by the sd
line to the Beginning it being eighty Acres more or less to
him and his Heirs forever.

I give and bequeath unto my son Edmund Doyle the Land
where he now lives beginning at the mouth of a little Branch
so up the sd Branch to John Bennets line then along the
said line to Sarahs Branch down the sd Branch to the
Beginning it being eighty Acres more or less to him and his
Heirs forever.
