Item I give unto my Daughter Darcos Burn one feather Bed &
furniture on the consideration that her Husband Hardy
Burn pay unto my executor twenty five shillings to the
use of the Estate to her & her Heirs

Item I give unto my Daughter Elizth Doyle twenty five shillings
current Money to her & her Heirs

Item I give unto my Wife Elizth all the remainder of my Estate
Goods and Chattels both within Doors and without during her
life or widowhood and after her decease or marriage there to be
equally divided betwixt all my Children lastly I do appoint
my Wife Elizth Doyle and my Son Hardy Doyle whole sole
Execs of this my last Will and Testament revoking disannul-
ling all other Wills heretofore made by me In Witnesst
hereof I have hereunto set my Hand Seal this the 22. Day of Feby
1762.
