This Will was presented in Court by Sarah Norton the executrix therein named proved by the Oath of Ann Faircloth a witness thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of the said executrix who made Oath Certificate was granted her for obtaining a probat thereof in due forme giving security.

In Obedience to an order of Southampton County Court bearing Date Jan^y 14th 1762. we the Subscribers first being Sworn before one of his Majesty's Justices of the Peace have appraised the Estate of Wm Dunn deceased and made true Inventory thereof as followeth.
