Jacob Darden I Jacob Darden of Smithyngton County Virginia do make and  
ordain this my last Will and Testament as follows viz First I give to  
my wife Mary Darden all the property both real and personal of which she  
was seized and possessed at the time of my intermarriage with her includ-  
ing the Land and slaves which she held as her Dower in the Estate of  
her first husband Shelly White decd and I do hereby ratify and confirm  
to her the rights of using & disposing of the personal property in any way  
that she may think proper as it more fully and particularly set forth by  
express in a certain Deed of Trust which was executed by myself and wife  
to Carr Bowes for that purpose bearing date the fourth day of September 1820  
D<sup>r</sup> Slaves and land to my wife Mary Darden for and during her natural  
life or widowhood the Land and plantation wherein I now live including all my  
land lying on the West side of the Cedar Swamp containing by estimation  
four hundred and seventy three acres more or less with the舍el & Boles  
now standing on the plantation also four negroes Zeb Coud Cat and  
Mourning two horses (her choice) my Shop Gag and harness with the chain  
whip and cushions two Bales with bedsteads and furniture, one Bureau one  
natural Table one Buffet with a set of China and half my other Bedding and  
glasp ware one close Bed and all my sitting Chairs one large red Chest half my  
floor Carpet, one looking glass her Choice six Table and six <sup>other</sup> Dresser  
one pair Bed Sheets and Bedding Table two meat barrels with Cops my Lumber  
bous with all my weaving utensils one Cotton and one Flax what 2/4 rods  
her choice all my Cedar basket and the applemitti and pynes all the old  
spints and Utensils now in the house with one barrel of rum apple Brandy  
and a Keg of Peach Brandy all the soap and Candles now in the house  
half my stock of hogs half of my Crop of all and every kind except Barley  
whether the same be housed or on the field at the time of my death soe heds of  
Cattle including two cows & calves one Woks of oxen half my stock of sheep  
my great turkey & other fowls 1/2 fire Pidgeons the Song & shord half  
dozen turkeys and fowls (her choice) half of my bread trays Tubs pails moggys  
baskets & Iron pots (her choice) one Pew table 1 Dutch oven 1 Dogong pan  
one spider 1 Boach of Iron skillets & iron sciss half my Demijohn jugs Case  
bottles Butter pots fronto and Tin ware 1 small tin sugar box for leaf sugar  
Dish tubs Two traps candlesticks (her choice) half my fish barrels and half the  
fish that may be on hand one Handsome & drawing knife with all the Augers  
Chisels gouges and grindall's now belonging to me 1 Barn Harness half my  
plantation utensils including Cart ploughs hoes axes spades & iron works  
all my Winding blades with my reel & Winding Jack with the spindles  
belonging to them half my Drals intended for flaxing meal Honey & sugar  
my Family Bed with such of my Books as she may choose to keep my  
Side saddle and riding saddle & Bridle all my Windon curtains with Sickets  
belonging to two tables half my Table cloths & Linens my Chest of mediation with  
all my Pheals 1 pair small Stithy crds all the sugar Coffe Tea flour of lead  
with all the Honey and preserves of every kind which may be on hand all the  
meal and cotton lags half the Pork and Bacon that may be killed and in the  
house at my death with all my dried fruits all the Cloth and spun Stuff that  
may be on hand all these articles are to be used by my said wife at her  
discretion for the support of herself and such family as she may choose to  
keep with her during her life in widowhood without impeachment of  
of waste & if at the time of my death there shall be anything owing or a other  
moneys to her from the hand of Negro man Jacob ob 2 w<sup>o</sup> the amount soe to be  
my said wife in fee simple.
