Will

I, Mary Chapman of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia doth make and ordain this to be my last will in manner and form as follows: Item 1st I give to my son William Chapman my negroes and Porter and Bond to him and his heirs forever Item 2nd I give to son William Chapman my negro Girl Lucy for the benefit of my daughter Catharine Jones and his my request that my son William give the said negro to my daughter Lucy and his heirs in any way he may think proper Item 3rd I give to my daughter Nancy Whiting my negroes Gilly, Annsonne and Meisden to her and her heirs forever with all their encumbrances to my daughter Nancy Whiting also her father's land and furniture that is our slaves the one she has got one chest and one linen stand wheel Item 4th I give to my grand daughter Caroline Chapman my negro woman abel and her increase to her and her heirs forever Item 5th I give to my grand daughter Mary Ann Jones one father's land furniture Item 6th I give to son William Chapman all the balance of my Estate both Real and Personal to him and his heirs upon this condition that my son William is to pay to my son John Chapman or to his heirs one hundred dollars if that his heirs should ever apply for it if they should never apply for the same in that case it is my wish that my son William Jones should have the hundred Dollars Lastly I leave my son William Jones my whole and sole Executor to this my last will as a that he secure to acquire of him upon his qualification in Court Given under my hand and this 29th day of Decr 1824 In presence of
