in the County of Hampshire a freeborn man do hereby certify that my last will and testa-
ment in manuscript and form following is the last and only one which I have made
Sally Sons the trustees of said John End in his last will and testament and
leading from Vick's Tavern to Bampton Church which I have signed and sealed
together with all the personal estate of every kind whatsoever except my soul for and
during her life and at her death I will that the said estate remain in the use
of my few youngest children namely Margaret Love Julia and Fanny during
their single lives and after their death I will that the said estate be divided
in said plantation and property. 3rd After the death of my wife and marriage
contract of the above named children Margaret Julia and Fanny and Edward
I give and bequeath the said plantation to my son John End to him and his
heirs forever and my personal estate to be sold and equally distributed among
my three youngest daughters Margaret Julia and Fanny or such of them
surviving at that time. 4th My said wife sold immediately after my death
for the benefit of my wife and her children Lady's Parsonage with con-
sents and appoint my wife whole and sole executrix to this my last will
and Testament revoking all others heretofore made by me This Testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this second day of
January in the Year of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty eight
in the presence of

Southampton County January Court 1828 This last will and Testament
of John End dec^d was proved in Court and there being no subscribing witness
there Dorothy Vick and Robert G. Simmons being sworn duly depose and
say that the said End acknowledged the said writing before him to be his
last will and Testament whereupon the same was ordered to be recorded as the
last will and Testament of the said John End dec^d and on the motion of
Sarah End the Executrix therein named also made oath and together with
Robert Denny and Robert G. Simmons her securities entered into an Ack^{nowledgment}
a bond in the penalty of \$1000 with Robert Denny and Robert G. Simmons as the Sureties
Certificate is granted the said Sarah End for Fanning a probate of said will
