I William Newell Esq. of the County of Southampson and State of Virginia being in tolerable health and of perfect sound mind and memory do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following. Item 1st I give devise and bequeath unto my son William Newell Two hundred acres of land to be laid off and attelld to him & also include the house wherow my son now resides with this part of the plantation to him and his heirs forvnd Item 2nd I give devise and bequeath unto my two daughters Nancy Newell wife of James Jones and Sally Newell wife of James Jones all the rest and residue of my lands to be equally among them between them this and a family Newell and Sally Newell to claim and clear from me Item 3rd I give devise and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Fannie West daughter of Sally West and her late wife Lucy formerly Lucy Weston one hundred Dollars to stand out of my Estate but on cond she and Fannie West stand sic under the age of twenty years without leaving a legitimate child or children living at the time of her death stand given devise and bequeath the said legacy of one hundred Dollars to be equally devide betw my children namely William Newell Nancy Newell and Sally Newell to them & their issue and assigns forever. Item 4th I give devise and bequeath all the rest and residue of my Estate of what nature or kind soever to my three children namely William Newell Nancy Newell and Sally Newell to be equally devide betw them to them and their issue for ever. Item 5th I declare that there be no sale of my Estate that my two children above named William Newell Nancy Newell and Sally Newell make choice of either of them to divide my Estate in kind as above named which division is to be binding betw them my said children In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 14th day of May One thousand eight hundred and twenty seven
