In obedience to the order of Court separating the Commissioners
bearing given the parties legal notice to appear before them on that day come
Lemuel Cook the adm^r Dr. Beniston and John W. V. and others attended
with R. Richards W. T. Water his counsel who objected to the account submitted by them
because he had failed to give his estate's ^{interests} credit for the proportion of ^{Beniston} Beniston
Cook's estate to which he said it was entitled in right of his wife who was ^{of} Southampton
said Cook who adm^r continued thus as Joshua Fort had not received his part of
the estate to proportion previous to the death of his wife and therefore the estate was
not entitled to it and thought that it properly belongs to the daughter of his estate and the
Commissioners however of opinion that the estate is entitled to all what she
here claims had the intestate wife been the longest lived one and has therefore
made up the account giving the estate credit by and equal proportion of the personal
estate a debt an equal proportion of the same slaves sold under a decree of the Court
since the death of his intestate.
