furniture one sugar Pew Pewank and sofa 4th Item in trust to her and her heirs forever
I 5th Item I give to my son William A. Branch his negro man named Bob & his & her heirs
for ever 6th Item I give to my son William A. Branch my Land & plantation
to be sold for Dollars to be spent in Secularies to him and his heirs forever 7th Item it is
my will and desire that all the rest of my Estate shall be by my Executrix laid down
hereafter among me and my Just debts & funeral expenses be paid out of the same
