The Executor exhibits a Bona account to his testator in his last form by Comptrol Branch a few days for 18 months from 1806 and the same is duly accounted in which a credit of twenty pounds is entered the 18th of February 1811 seven days after the Bona account is returned and a balance is set to the testator's credit there is a number of payments and entries on said Bona all of which the testator must receive by the Comptrol Branch to inform the testator gave his article of settlement for a period of twelve months he also received a copy of the same and filed them in his balance sheet on 20th of June 1811 on the 19th day of May 1813 at which time the last payment was made of \$77 25 the testator gave no credit for this balance as he is uncertain whether he had received the same and at the same time he did not receive the testator's commission the testator is not bound to receive the money should be collected.
