In the name of God Amen I James Edwards of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
being of Sound Mind and memory do make showing last Will and Testament in manner and form following viz
I hereby bequeath the tract of land and plantation whereon I now live and there adjacent viz the land
Mary to my wife Martha Edwards and my son Barn Edwards during her natural life but not to be taken
at her death or marriage I give to my son Barn Edwards the above mentioned property to have and
hold forever I also give to my wife Martha Edwards one hundred dollars in cash one dozen best
fur mittens one can and half dozen I give to my son Barn Edwards Three hundred dollars in
cash also one crop horse I give to my son Allen Edwards one negro boy which he has now
propose to have and to hold forever I then I give to my daughter Margaret one negro woman
which she has now propose to have and to hold forever I then I give to my son James
Edwards one hundred dollars in cash one negro boy and one negro woman which he has now to have
for ever I then I give to my daughter Elizabeth Musgrave one negro woman Coney & shut her out
of all I make her equal to what I have given to my other children I then I
deserve my tract of Land lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia in the
proportion of the balance of my Estate which is not intended to be liquidated and divided among my
Allen Edwards my son John and my daughter Margaret one and my daughter Elizabeth
one and my son Richard one eighth children one eighth child one eighth child one eighth child
equaling divided it eleven children more times Children Martha's sister Martha's sister
Elizabeth's sister Emma's sister William's sister James's sister Mary's sister Thomas's sister
to have and their heirs forever Partly I hereby recommend and appoint my son Allen
Edwards Executor to this my last Will and Testament hereby ratifying and confirming
declaring this to be my last Will and Testament which I the said James Edwards
have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 24th day of October 1751

Imprimis

In the name of God Amen I Edward Price of sound and disposing mind and memory do
make and ordain this my last Will and Testament hereby giving and appointing by my last Will and
Testament that my Executor hereinafter named should sell all my personal Estate and
the plantation on which I now reside including the land called Adams's and also the
adjoining to which I have a right legal or equitable on a great not less than twelve months
and of the proceeds after deducting the legacy to my daughter Mary Price for the said
my debt I then I bequeath and give to my son John Price a half share of the whole of the
Land divided to my four children by William Williams late of Southampton County and
by his last Will together with the land and appurtenances I also give to him and his heirs
a parcel of Land adjoining the same which I purchased of one William Williams and
also my Executor to pay share for my said son John a negro man of his choice at the
rate of the slave left by his said former father William Williams the price of which
to be deducted from John's proportion of the sales of the said slaves I then I give to
my son William Price the same and more with the appurtenances which I purchased
