I do hereby certify that the said Jordan Seymour and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear to the said Seymour and in consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid by the said Harrison Seymour also before the entering and delivering of these presents this receipt whereof I bear by an acknowledgment have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Harrison Seymour his Executors administrators and assigns all the personal property that I before the said presents have left with you and all the property that I shall be or become proprietor of or have I shall or will acquire or receive from my or to dispose of my plantation for the best profits and divide it between Emma M. Williams the said Seymour and Mansel Seymour To have and to hold the said property above mentioned unto him the said Mansel Seymour his Executors administrators and assigns forever And the said Jordan Seymour for himself his Executors heirs and assigns unto the said Harrison Seymour his Executors administrators and assigns against the claim of him the said Jordan Seymour his Executors heirs and assigns the claim or claims of act and every person or persons whatsoever that and were warrant and forever defend them by these presents In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty first day of September eighteen hundred and twenty eight

A Court held for Southampton County the 19th January 1839
This writing purporting the last will and Testament of Jordan Soyner
deceased was produced in Court and Jonathan Scott being sworn deposed and each said
he truly believes as well the body of the said will as the signature thereto to be in the
proper hand writing of the said Jordan Soyner at the time it was due and that the
said writing be established as and for the last will and Testament of the said
Jordan Soyner and the same be received and on the motion of Henry S. Rogers
who made oath thereto and together with Jordan Edwards and Jonathan Scott
he delivered evidence and acknowledged in Court in the presence of three sheri-
ffs and a jury as directed in the Law directed. Certificate of grant of the said will
read. Soyner for obtaining a writ of administration on the said Jordan Soyner's
Estate with his will afore said annexed due form.

this my last Will and Testament as follows. First I desire that my just debts
and funeral expenses first be paid out of my perishable Estate. Secondly I bear to my
beloved wife Sally Pope the tract of land wherein I now live the tract of land purchased
of Wiley Coyner also the tract of land purchased of Machum Pope as Executor of
Machum Coyner dec'd and one third part of my personal and perishable Estate
during her life her widowhood Thirdly I give my son Benj^d & Pope the land
and plantation purchased of Carter Cunningham and an Equal share to each the balance
of my Children in the perishable Estate to them and his heirs forever Fourthly
I give to my son Thomas Pope the following tracts of land vizt. I give the land
purchased of Thomas & Anne near Monroe called the Backland place also
I give I give him the plantation wherein I now live at his mothers death or
marriage also I give him the place purchased of Machum Pope as Executor of
