Will

In the name of God. Amen I William Claus of the County of Southampton
and State of Virginia do make and declare this my last will and Testament.
In manner and form as follows. Given the 1st day to my wife Mary Claus
all my lands during her natural life or widowhood and at the death of my wife
my will and desire is that all my lands be sold and the money arising therefrom
be equally divided between all my living children. Item 2nd After the
payment of all my just debts and funeral expenses I leave to my wife Mary
Claus the following slaves to be divided among them. Nancy Claus. Mary Little
during her natural life or widowhood also the balance of my slaves. Then
to my said wife Mary Claus until either of my daughters Mary
or Anna at the age of twenty one year my will and desire is that
when either of my daughters get married or arrive at the age of twenty one year
that she shall have an equal share or proportion of all my slaves which
I have not loaned to my wife Mary Claus during life or widowhood
also my will and desire is that should there be any increase from either of
these negro women which I have loaned to my wife during life after my
death that they should be considered as a loan to my wife until the same
between my daughter who will be Mary or Anna at the age of twenty one year
Item I leave to my wife Mary Claus the use of all my household and
Kitchen furniture and Stock of all kinds plantation utensils & during
her natural life or widowhood except when either of my daughters shall
get married or arrive at the age of twenty one year my will and desire
is that then the said daughter or daughter should have one hundred
100. and Furniture one Horse of the value of Twenty five dollars two Combs
valued two dollars & pds each of equal value. Item 3rd In case my wife Mary
Claus should die before my daughter Nancy married at the age of twenty one
year or marry my will and desire is that the plantation be kept up together
with all its appurtenances thence amount until my daughter Nancy Claus
arrives at the age of twenty one year or marries then my will desire is that
all my household and Kitchen furniture stock of all kinds plantation utensils
that I have not given in the first legacies to be sold and the money arising
therefrom to be equally divided between all my living children. And Lastly
I do hereby ^{entirely} dispossess my wife Mary Claus of my whole one sole Executive
to this my last will and Testament Given under my Hand and Seal the 1st day of August one thousand eight hundred and twenty five
