In the name of God Amen I Joseph Barnes of the County of Southampton being of
 lawful mind and memory do make this my last will and Testament in manner and form as
 follows. I Give to Francis Coleman my nephew and my land lying on the south
 side of the road leading from Southampton to Basingstoke the ten Acres of land
 comes of lawful age at which time the said Francis Coleman shall have it
 but if the said Francis Coleman shall die before he comes to the age of twenty
 one years then my will and desire is that the said land shall go to his brothers and
 his first by the father's side. I Give to John and William sons of
 Francis Coleman all my land lying on the north side of the said road
 to them and their heirs for ever. I Give to my wife Elizabeth all the
 balance of my Estate of all kinds to the children of Elizabeth Coleman and their
 heirs and their heirs forever. I Witness my hand and seal this 2nd day of January 1787
