Martha Davis being found of sound mind and memory do make and declare my last Will &
Testament. Item 1st I give my son Thomas A. Davis during his natural life
three pieces of land and one flat and one half and after his death to be divided
between the children of my daughter Indra Coker to them and their heirs forever
Item 2nd Betty Hill and desire it that my land on a testimony with my other property on the
same be sold and after paying my just debts the balance is to be divided among the living
members of the household to Indra Coker and her heirs forever one third to Thomas A.
Davis but should he die without lawful heir then another part to go to Indra
Coker and her heirs forever one third to my son Robert Davis but should he die
ago or without lawfull heir then I give his one third part to my daughter Indra
Coker to her and her heirs forever also I give to my son Robert Davis one negro
woman named Phyllis and three children namely Eliza Nancy and Liza together
with all his increase from his day also entitled one acre one half and one quarter of child
but should he die under age or without lawfull heir then I give the said negro & property to
my daughter Indra Coker and her heirs forever.

Item 3rd My Will and desire is that at the death of my mother in Law named
Sarah all the Estate coming to my husband be sold in 2 parts and received one from
the proceeds thereof I give to my grand daughter Lucy Coker one hundred and fifty
dollars also to my grandson John Coker I give one hundred dollars also to the
children of my daughter of my daughter Sally Hill namely Thomas Coker and John A.
I give one hundred dollars also equally between them and the balance of any
left over under the following manner to be. One third to Indra Coker to her and her heirs
one third to Thomas Davis but if he dies without lawfull heir I give the one third to Indra
Coker to her and her heirs forever One third to my son Robert Davis but should he die
under age or without lawfull heir then I give this one third to Indra Coker to her and
her heirs forever Item 4th I hereby appoint my son in law Mr. Coker
Executor of this my last Will and Testament leaving all others M. M. B.
whom I have left my hand this 24th day of March the thousand eight hundred
and twenty nine
