and ordain my last Will as follows. I give to my sister Lizzy with or without
hundred dollars to her and her heirs forever. I lend to my wife a money bond
during her life or widowhood the residue of my Estate of every description after
paying all my just debts and the before mentioned legacy to my sister and
at her death or marriage I give the land whereon I now live and the tract commonly
called Williams's to her sons Abner R Thompson and John Thompson
upon Condition that they pay to the Grand daughter of my wife Martha
Thomas Edwards one third part of the value of said land to be ascertained by
appraisement and the remainder of the Estate to be my wife to be equally
divided between her sons and Grand daughter above named
I appoint Benjamin Edwards and my wife Executor and executrix to this my Will

day of March One thousand eight hundred and twenty nine
