heirs forever. I do give and bequeath to my beloved Sister Mary Royal the sum of
Five hundred Dollars to her and her heirs forever. I do give and bequeath
to my niece Sarah Williams the sum of Three Pounds E. Dollars in Cash to her and
her heirs forever. I do give and bequeath to my nephew James Williams the
sum of Three Pounds E. dollars in Cash to him and his heirs forever. I do give and
bequeath to my beloved Cousin William E. Lawrence the sum of one Pound E. Dollars
in Cash and my brace of Pistols to him and his heirs forever. I do give and bequeath
to my Cousin Martha Royal the sum of twenty five Dollars in Cash to her and her
heirs forever. I do give and bequeath to my beloved uncle William Lawrence the
sum of Five hundred dollars in Cash to him and his heirs forever. I do also
appoint and name my Uncle William Lawrence Guardian to the above named Martha and
James Williams. I do appoint and leave my beloved Uncle William Lawrence with
the Executor of this my last Will and Testament declaring that to be my last Will and
