John Bennett In the Name of God Amen I, Rebecca Bennett being weak in body but of sound mind and memory do think proper to make and Ordain this writing to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say:

I give unto my friend Mr. Wilmot Steddyfield for and during his natural life all my Interest in and to the now in tract of Land which has fallen to me by the death of my four brothers and now in the opinion of my brother Samuel Bennett together with the residue of my brother Ted's Land furniture and one Chest and other effects I give and bequeath the above named bed and Chest to Wm. T. Steddyfield son of the said Wilmot Steddyfield to have and his heirs for ever.

I give and bequeath to William T. Steddyfield John McAlpin and George McAlpin Sons of Wilmot Steddyfield after the death of the said Wilmot Steddyfield all the right title and interest which he may have in and to the said lands which I have bequeathed the said Wilmot Steddyfield to be equally divided between them and their heirs forever.

Lastly I do nominate constitute and appoint my friend Wilmot Steddyfield as my whole and sole Executor to the my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 23rd day of Nov 1829.
