wheel riding Carrage and Coach of my collection belte one half of my empoyment
hogheads all my Utensils that is not always given away to him and his heirs forever.

I give to my daughter Deborah Ricks thirty shares in the Virginie States

Bank to her and her heirs forever.

I give my Will that whatever Estate there may be left after paying the above
several legacies may be equally divided betwixt my son George W. Ricks & Mrs.
Ricks Alfred Ricks and my daughter Deborah Ricks. I constitute and
appoint my son Oliver Ricks Executor to this my last Will and Test-
ament. In witness whereof I have alwaye hand and seal this 2^d day of
May One thousand eight hundred and twenty three.

A Court held for the County of Southampton the 21st day of December 1829.
The last Will and Testament of Richard Ricks deceased was proved by the
oath of Thomas Rector and affirmation of James Peltor the witnessed sealed
and recorded and on the motion of Oliver Ricks the Executor there was
who affirmed and together with Thomas Rector Robert Ricks Jr and Alfred
Ricks his de curators entered into and acknowledged a Bond on the property of
Thirty Thousand dollars conditioned at the sum due to certificate w/ grantee the
said Oliver Ricks for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form

July 1st 1830 I Faculty. To you of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia do hereby
make my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say
1st I Will that my Executor hereafter named do as soon as convenient after my decease
sell all of my Estate of every kind and of the procree thereof pay all my just debts & expenses
or with the expences of my interment and also all expences incurred on accont
the execution of my Will.

2nd I give and bequeath to my son Oliver Ricks two hundred dollars of the procree of
the estate as before directed to him my said son and his heirs forever.

3rd I give and bequeath to my granddaughter Mary Lester daughter of my said son
Oliver Ricks One hundred dollars of the procree of the estate as aforesaid to her my said
granddaughter and her heirs forever.

4th I give and bequeath to my grandson Christopher Hartman son of John Hartman
fifty dollars out of the procree of the estate as a present to him my said Grandson and his
heirs forever.

5th I direct that the residue of my Estate be divided into six equal parts or lots to
of which I give to my daughter Lydia Ricks to her and her heirs forever one
lot of which I give to my daughter Mary Lester to her and her heirs forever and
the other parts lot of which I give to my daughter Mary Ricks
to her and her heirs forever.
