A Court held for the fixing of Surchamples the 21st day of December 1839.
And last Will and Testament of Richard Pickers deceased proved by the
oath of Thomas Pritton and affirmation of Amos Pritton the Minister of the
said Church and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of Oliver Pickers the Ecclesiastical Registrar
who affirms and together with Thomas Pritton Robert Pickers Jr and Alfred
Pickers his de curia entered into and acknowledge a Bond in the penalty of
Thirty Thousand dollar conditioned as the Law directs certificate is granted the
said Oliver Pickers for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form
Wm Small Poole & Co.

I, Sally, Sonner of the County of Northampton in the State of Virginia do hereby make my last Will and Testament in manner and form following, that is to say
1st I Will that my Executor hereafter named do as soon as convenient after my decease settle all of my Estate of every kind and of the procurement of pay all my just debts together with the expenses of my interment and also all expenses incurred on and by the execution of my Will.

2nd I give and bequeath unto my son Willie Rogers two hundred dollars of the proceeds of the sale as before directed to him, my said son and his heirs forever.

333. I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Mary Dwyer daughter of my said son
Wm one hundred dollars of the proceeds of the sale of a certain lot of my late
grand daughter and his heirs forever.

4 I give and bequeath to my grand son Christl. Heirs son of John Heirs
fully disband out of the presence of the state as a present to him my last lands and all his
his heirs forever

5th I agree that the residue of my Estate be divided into three equal parts or lot one lot of which I give to my daughter Lydia Dick to her and her heirs forever the other lot of which I give to my daughter Mary Haller to her and her daughter and her heirs forever the other part or lot of which I give to my daughter Nancy Dick to her and her heirs forever and her heirs forever.
