natural life, provided she shall educate and raise my children and support them out of
my Estate as generously as her situation will admit.

2nd I Will that at the death of my wife Elizabeth that my Estate be then divided equally
between my children

3rd I nominate and appoint my wife Elizabeth Myrick my whole and sole Executrix to the my
last will and testament and furthermore Will that she have full power security of the said
Executrix her heirs executors and assigns null and void all former Wills and bequests by me
hitherto made and satisfying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 9 day of September in the
Year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty nine
