Will

I, Sally Bryant of the County of Southampton in the State of New York do hereby make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say

1st I desire my Executors after making a distribution as convenient after my decease of all my Estate except Articles of Property hereinafter mentioned specified and out of the monies raised therefrom pay and discharge all my just debts of any also expended of interest together with the cost of the final execution of this my will. 2nd After the payment of Debts and expenses as aforesaid I give to my daughter Lucy Wick one dollar to her my said daughter and her heirs forever. 3rd I also give to my daughter Eliza Bryant one dollar to her my said daughter and her heirs forever.

4th I give to my daughter Lucy Bryant one young Cow and breeding four one sow and two hams two female geese and one male with three chickens three guinea chickens one turkey hen one hundred pounds of pork and one negro woman slave named Flossie to her my said daughter and her heirs forever. 5th I give to my daughter Lurina Bryant one cow having an horn and Calf one large black planted Chest one figure Counterpane also one fifth of the household money to her as above provided and left after the payment of my debts expended and the two first legacies of one dollar each to her my said daughter and her heirs forever.

6th I give to my daughter Matilda Bryant one large red Cow and Calf also one fifth of the remainder of what after the appropriation herein first made in manner last before said to her my said daughter and her heirs forever. 7th I give to Master William Bryant one fifth of the remainder paid after the appropriation herein made as aforesaid to him my son and his heirs forever.

8th I give to my daughter Sarah Bryant one fifth of the residue of what after the appropriation is made aforesaid to him my said son and his heirs forever.

9th I give to my son Benjamin Bryant one gray colt and one fifth of the residue of what after the appropriation is made as aforesaid to my said son and his heirs forever.

Lastly, having fully disposed of my Estate in the foregoing manner, I do hereby nominate and appoint my worthy friend John Thomas the Executor of this my last Will and Testament.
