In the Name of God Amen I Iife Hobolt of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say

I give unto my wife Nancy Hobolt the following negro servant Henry George John Hobolt & his family Ruth and Will and their future increase also three hundred dollars in Gold to her and her heirs forever provided my wife abides by this my last Will and Testament otherwise the said negro and money must continue in my Estate and be subject to my will as it respects my personal Estate.

- Item 1st I give unto my nephew Ethelred Hobolt of Johnson County State of North Carolina Five Thousand dollars to him and his heirs forever
- Item 2nd I give unto my nephew William Hobolt Children to wit Sophia Eliza Random Green and Daniel Hobolt Twenty five hundred dollars to them and to their heirs forever but if either of them should die before they arrive to lawful age or Marriage it is my Will and desire that the survivors shall have the afo^r respective part.
- Item 3rd I give unto my nephew Solomon Edward of Nash County State of North Carolina Five Thousand dollars to him and his heirs forever
- Item 4th I give unto Joshua S. Gland son of Emma Cloud at the death of my wife one thousand dollars to him and his heirs forever
- Item 5th I give unto my friend Willie Francis in case he survives me One Thousand dollars to him and his heirs forever
- Item 6th I send unto my wife Nancy Hobolt the balance of my Estate notwithstanding her real and personal during her natural life & widowhood
- Item 7th At the death or marriage of my wife I give unto Joseph S. Gland the whole of my Lands lying in the County of Southampton containing Three Hundred and Eighty acres together with some more or less to him and his heirs forever
- Item 8th At the death or marriage of my wife I give unto Joseph S. Gland and Samuel Drury all my slaves together with the rest residue and remainder of my whole Estate of whatsoever kind or description it may be not herein before particularly disposed of consisting of the whole of my personal Estate loaned to my wife to be equally divided between them to them and their heirs forever
- Item 10th It is my Will and desire that whosoever receives and enjoys my personal Estate shall do to Charlotte Day a decent and comfortable support and maintenance during her life
- Item 11th I do hereby constitute and appoint Joseph S. Gland and Samuel Drury Executors to my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other Wills or Testaments by me hitherto made In witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the 21st day of November one thousand eight hundred and Ninety Eight

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 10th day of August 1830
The last Will and Testament of Iife Hobolt was pronounced by the oath of Henry Hobolt
John Drury two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded And in the witness of
Joseph S. Gland and Samuel Drury the Executors thereto named who made with an Oath
with William J. Gorham Peter Edward William & Jones John Drury & Willie Francis
their securities entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars
and to them as the same direct. Certificate is granted the said Joseph S. Gland and Samuel
Drury for attesting of the said Will in our favor
