body but of Law mind and memory do make proper to make and cause this writing to be my last Will and Testament
in manner and form following to wit
I Give My Will and desire is that my Executor hereinafter named shall see publicly or privately as much
of my property that can be best shewn will be sufficient to pay all my just debts
I Give unto my beloved wife Polly Bond for and during her Natural life or if she survives all her main-
dors part of my Estate both real and personal after paying my just debts as above mentioned. But should she
die many then my last is that my Estate should be sold and she to take such part of the same as I see
fit during life
I Give My Will and desire is after the death or Marriage of my wife that my Executor shall sell and
remainder of my Estate which may be the left and the amount arising from the sale of the same to be
equally divided between all my then living children to them and their heirs forever
I Give My Willing nomination constitute and appoint my son Thomas Bond as my whole and sole
Executor to that my last Will and Testament and reserving all other rights for my estate. In testimony

Lord Christ one thousand Eight hundred and thirty three

their heirs forever and I hereby utterly disavow revoke and disannul all and every other former Will
