 1830 in the State of Virginia being duly sworn shall so make and my last will and
 Testament in the manner and form following to wit:
 1st It is my will and desire that my wife Susan should be maintain and keep my wife
 2nd I give unto my daughter Eliza one cow and calf & her gun one that Gladys & Hunter
 also and equal proportion of my other property as with the other heirs
 3rd It is my will and desire that my son William should have my land providing he pay
 the other heirs their proportionable part at the rate of three hundred and fifty dollars for
 the whole of it
 4th If my son William should fail to pay the other heirs their proportionable part at
 that rate It is my desire that my son Matthew should have the same chances
 the land as I have herein given my son William In witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand & my seal at my last will and Testament this 1st day
 of September 1830

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 18th day of October 1830
 The last will and Testament of Joel Vick deceased was proved by the oath of
 Richard Jordan Thomas Vick and Jacobus Pope the 1st The witnesses and ordered
 to be recorded And at a Court held for the County aforesaid the 18th day of November
 1830 On the Motion of Matthew Vick (John Vick widow and executrix of the last
 Joel Vick having relinquished her right of administration to the said Matthew Vick)
 who made oath and together with John Blagrove and David Edmonson her co-
 executrixes and acknowledges a Bond in the County of the said and before sitting
 as the Law directs Certificate is granted to the said Matthew Vick her co-
 administration on the said Joel Vick's estate with his executors said administration
 due forms

In the name of God Amen I Catharine Barrett of Southampton County Virginia
 1830 knowing the mortality of man and being in health and of sound mind and memory do make
 and Ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following to wit
 First My will and desire is that all my just debts should be paid
 Secondly My will and desire is that at my death all my black people should be free
 and as well as follows Fred. Dennis Peter Miles Henry and young and I intended
 them free as if any
 Thirdly I give to my son John Barrett the whole of my land and I intended my said
 property of least the Land whereon I live and together with the part of land adjoining
 the same that Benjamin Barrett bought of John Barrett Upon this proviso that the
 said John Barrett shall or shall pay to my estate in two years after my death
 one thousand dollars the said land to be for property before the said John Barrett
 has been for ever I give to my grandson Benjamin Barrett son of John Barrett
 half dozen black tender chairs also I give to my grandson David Barrett son of John Barrett
 ten Spoons also I give to my grandson Benjamin Barrett son of John Barrett
 I give to my daughter Lydia Barrett ten dollars to her and her heirs forever And I intended
 grand daughter Lucy Barrett ten dollars to her and her heirs forever And I intended
 it that after my death all my estate not thereby disposed of should be divided
 my Bond or account I have in my just debts against the time of my death and my
 heirs should be divided as follows I give to each one half part of my estate to my son
 William Barrett son of Barrett Barrett deceased and should said William & Barrett
 without legal issue that each part to be divided as follows in their shares
