

At a Court held for the County of Lincolnhampton the 2^d day of December 1830
 First sitting pursuant to the Will of Edmund Beale dec^d and proffered on Court by
 Thomas Morrell and Edmund Thorpe of the Execution thereon named for probat
 and thereupon Thomas Morrell appeared by his Attorney and offered the probat of the said
 Will and thereupon the Will was read and examined and adjudged
 by the Court to be validly proved it is the opinion of the Court that the said Will is the
 true last Will and Testament of the said Edmund Beale dec^d and that the said Will
 be executed the same was read and considered and pronounced upon and it is ordered that
 the same be proved. And on the motion of Thomas Morrell and Edmund Thorpe
 two of the Execution thereon named (Henry being deceased for which the other
 Execution thereon named to qualify as his heirs and assigns) who made oath and together
 with Lewis Morrell and Miles Thorpe their executors entered into and acknowledged
 a Bond on the penalty of Ten Thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs
 to satisfy as granted the said Thomas Morrell and Edmund Thorpe for obtaining
 a probat of the said Will in due form
