Gilphias dec^d of Northampton County being sick but of a sound mind and memory do think proper to make and Ordain this as my last will and Testament in witness whereof and form following to wit.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Edshad Lewis one feather bed and furniture just choice one chest and one large feather desk and brown one half candle stick and table set and dinner set that if a days plate just choice to him and his heirs forever

Item I give to my daughter Elizabeth one feather bed and furniture one was being tub & water fail & death oven

Item I give to my son John Lewis the bed that I had to him and to Myrins daughter of John Lewis my horse and gear and to them and their heirs forever and to John Lewis daughter of Edgal with one feather desk

I will the balance of my Estate to be held and after paying my just debts to be equally divided between the rest of my children namely John Lewis, Alced Lewis and Elizabeth Turner and to their heirs forever

I constitute and appoint Joel Samuel my Executor to the my last will and Testament revoking and making all other wills heretofore made by me null & void in respect of the said Gilphias dec^d hand hereunto set her hand the 17th day of May 1828.

At a Court held for the County of Northampton the 16th day of January 1832
This last will and Testament of Gilphias dec^d was proved by the oath of James Harris and Henry Council the Witnesses thereof and ordered to be recorded and on the 20th day of Feb^r 1832 the Executor therein named did make oath and to gather with James Harris and Henry Council her securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs.
