18. A bond held for the money of £1000 on the 16 day of January 1831.
19. A paper writing purporting to be the last will and Testament of Salathiel Thomas dec'd
was produced to the Court for probate and there being six Subscribers, Wmth of Wmth John Davis
Harris Harris and John P. Williams were deposed, sworn and they all say that they never saw
or heard of the said writing of the said Salathiel Thomas and never believe that
the said writing of the said writing is at all as it is signed and that it is not the proper hand
writing of the said Salathiel Thomas. All the aforesaid the Court being satisfied
with the facts that the said writing be voided as and for the last will and Testament
of the said Salathiel Thomas dec'd.

 State of Maryland being of legal age do hereby certify and God bless God do hereby certify
 in so joyful a Land and perfect mind and manner do make and solemnize my last
 Will and Testament in manner and form following (112)

Thirdly, Key McCall and I desire is that all my just debts be paid, after that I send my daughter Hannah Case my Secretary and Geo. Case, my large looking Glaph is the Hall during his lifetime after that I give to my grand daughter Annell C. Case the same Secretary and Rook Case also the large looking Glaph he and she him's forever.

And finally I give to my daughter Mariah T. Hickam my Portabed already, also the feather bed which is on it together with two Counterpane, two bed quilts, two sheets and certain things belonging, also my clock and small stained dropping Table linen and her trunks forever.

Thirdly, my will and desire is that after all my just debts be paid, the balance of my property, to which I have not disposed of, to be sold if any one one half of the money arising from such sale I give to my daughter Martha F. B. and to her and her heirs forever.

Fourthly, I gave to my son John Graham the Sum of five dollars Cash to him and his heirs forever.

Finally I give to my son Timothy Kinsman the sum of five dollars Cash to him and he has him conveyed

Truly I give to my son Joseph Benthams the sum of five dollars in cash to him and his heirs forever

Finally, I send to my daughter Nancy Rose one half of the balance of the sales given for my stock. I have not disposed of, after all my just debt is paid and the said balance will be paid in full of my stock to be kept during her life time, and at her death I give it to my grand daughter Maria to have to her own disposal.

Explicitly I quote my Grandson's Testament & solemnly all the children of the young of my country in the State, at being the chief of the balance, and so it should be before the go of every one, you still be in the noblest of the Kingdom and the land forever.

Soberly, temperately and impartially, as far as possible, to
do that my duty as a citizen requires me to do.
