 1st After the payment of my debts and funeral expenses, I give to my mother my money and lands to be enjoyed by her forever.
 2nd I give to my mother Susanna Cobb all my Estate which is at present in my possession also the negroes which my Estate will be entitled to at the death of Aunt Polly Mason and all my interest in any land or property whatever that may not at present be in my possession during my natural life and after her decease I give the same to the children of my son & Hamel Wicks son of Peter and the children of my son & Amilia Mary Mason daughter of Peter to be equally divided among them and to be enjoyed by them forever.

And Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my Mother Susanna Cobb Executrix of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other or former Wills or Testaments by me hitherto made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 25th day of November in the Year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty one

Gardner of Southampton County and State of Virginia being weak in body but of sound perfect mind and memory thankful to Almighty God for the same and calling to mind the uncertainty of human life to make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say
 I desire all my just debts and burial charges to paid and discharged as soon as convenient will admit.

Item 1st I slender to my beloved wife Tabitha one third part of all my Estate except my Negro slave Hendricka alias Harry, old Lucy of my Lucy and Eliza for and during her single life.

Item 2nd I give unto my daughter Barbara Elizance the land and plantation I bought of Solomon Daughtry and his Negro named Mingo and Minty to her and her heirs forever.

Item 3rd I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Frances Gardner the land and plantation the said Gardner is or called my old plantation and his negro named Michael and Cerry to her and her heirs forever.

Item I gave unto my Nephew John H. Powell buying my Slave girl called New gun that Mr. Powell stocked to him and his heirs forever.

I desire the balance of my Estate not heretofore named to be equally divided between my two
