In the name of God Amen I Sally Enright of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia being in my perfect senses do make this my last Will and Testament in the following manner Viz.

First I desire that my Executors hereafter named may have my body buried in a Christian like manner

Secondly I send unto my friend Joseph Snipes three Negroes named Aaron, Polina and Matthew during his life and at his death to be returned to Peter Farrisclab.

3rd I send unto my friend John T. Flove, two Negroes named Isham and Patsy and at his death they are to be returned to Peter Farrisclab, I also give to John T. Flove two hundred dollars in money

4th I send unto my friend L. L. Talley Mason one Negro woman named Mary during his life and at his death to be returned to Peter Farrisclab

5th I do give and bequeath to my friend D. C. D. Ruchow, my side board and a few furniture belonging to it.

Now I give and bequeath unto Peter Farrisclab, two Negroes named Willard and Lucy one bed & furniture &c

Now I send unto my friend Joseph Snipes one half of my tract of land (where I now live, during his life, I also give him one of my Cattle

Now I give unto Peter Farrisclab the other half of my tract of land

Now I give and bequeath unto Benjamin Cook and Negro woman named Mary My desire is after my just debts are paid the remainder to be equally divided between Peter Farrisclab, John T. Flove, and Joseph Snipes. Should Peter Farrisclab die before he arrives to the age of twenty one years my desire is that his part of the land shall go to Samuel May Jr, and his other property shall be equally divided
