

Commissioners Office July 28th 1832. The parties interested in the Settlement of Richard Halcome's Estate commended by Mary Halcome or as agent helpful to attend the day and summing. Wm. Howell Summons to give evidence in relation to the Board of Eliza Halcome who is one of the debtors; and from the evidence so taken to be held with all the circumstances the Court is clearly of opinion that board ought to be charged for the period from 1826 to 1830 both years inclusive. That account was again confirmed at the instance of John Scott, who is interested in right of his late wife Mary formerly Halcome who was one of the debtors, so he gave full an account for Board for herself and children owing & by the administration, and Eliza Halcome were examined and affidavits taken, from which the Court is clearly of opinion that Board less than his years Board ought to be charged which would embrace the years in part 1826, 1827, & 1828. The parties admit that the administration is established for Paranna Halcome for the year 1818. who was an invalid and confined herself to her bed the sum of £85. Richard and Nancy Halcome admits sum of £1000 owing in the year 1821 as charged by administration.
